You are hereby notified of the commencement of the statutory public review period of the abovementioned environmental applications.

The Phase 1 and Phase 2 Extension Houmoed Avenue projects fall inside the southern fringes of the so-called Pick-'n-Pay reedbed wetlands. This area, especially the Phase 1 portion, is deemed important habitat for the Western Leopard Toad. The Faunal specialist studies undertaken recommended that Toad Nuts review and provide comment on the proposed mitigation measures as put forward by both the Freshwater Ecologist and the Faunal Specialist on the project. We would therefore be grateful for any comments you may have in this regard.

Notice is hereby given of two Public Participation Processes (PPP) in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, as amended, contained in section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and in terms of the Water Use Licence Application and Appeals Regulations as per the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998).

THE PROPOSED PHASE 1 EXTENSION OF HOUMOED AVENUE, SUNNYDALE
 (DEA:DP Pre-application REF: 16/3/3/6/7/1/F1/45/2016/17 and DWS WULA Pre-application Reference: 16/2/7)

The City of Cape Town's Transport and Urban Development Authority (CCT: TDA) is proposing to extend Houmoed Avenue in Sunnydale up to Lekkerwater Road. The total length of the extension is 1218m and extends over 8 properties. The majority of the proposed route lies within an existing road reserve which starts at the intersection of Noordhoek Road, runs along an existing section of Houmoed Avenue and then extends adjacent to the Long Beach Mall and the residential suburbs of Milkwood Park and Noordsig to link up with the northern end of Lekkerwater Road to the west.

Refer to the locality map included as **Appendix A**.

Detailed information on the abovementioned application was included in the pre-application Basic Assessment Report which underwent a 30-day public review period from 25 July 2018 – 25 August 2018. This letter serves to notify that the post-application Basic Assessment Report, Water Use License Application and supporting documentation are now available for a final round of 30-day public review (details provided elsewhere in this letter).

2. THE PROPOSED <u>PHASE 2</u> EXTENSION OF HOUMOED AVENUE AND UPGRADING OF MASIPHUMELELE INFORMAL SETTLEMENT, SUNNYDALE AND MASIPHUMELELE, CAPE TOWN.

(DEA:DP REF: 16/3/3/6/7/1/A6/50/2153/17 and DWS WULA Pre-application Reference : 16/2/7)

Phase two of the project entails the extension of the existing portion of Houmoed Avenue from Fish Eagle Park in the west up to Lekkerwater Road. The project would also entail the upgrade of the informal settlement currently located to the north of the formal housing in Masiphumelele. It is approximated that 2500 households are currently located in this area and it is anticipated that approximately 1500 households can be accommodated subsequent to the informal settlement

upgrade. This will be dependent on the housing typologies ultimately determined during the final design stage. Relocation of approximately 1000 households will therefore be necessitated. Relocation will take place to properties within a 5km radius of the site. The total length of the road extension is 940m and extends over 7 properties. It runs inside existing informal settlement infilled area and the portions of the southern fringes of the adjacent wetland (part of the greater Noordhoek wetland system). The road would ultimately form the boundary between the wetland and the proposed housing settlement.

Refer to the locality map included as **Appendix A**.

Two route alternatives are being considered for the eastern end of the proposed road:

- Route Alternative 1 (Preferred alternative) would curve slightly to the south and would tie into the existing northern end of Lekkerwater Road.
- Route Alternative 2 would continue in a straight line eastwards, to run roughly through the middle of the residential properties Erf 66/944 and Erf 67/944. Lekkerwater Road will be extended northwards (along the eastern boundary of Erf 66/944) by approximately 100m and will tie into the proposed horizontal alignment of the Houmoed extension.

The route alternatives are detailed in the post-application Basic Assessment Report. Note that owing to timing constraints, no pre-application public review of the documentation was undertaken. Other public participation activities did however precede the formal application process. 
