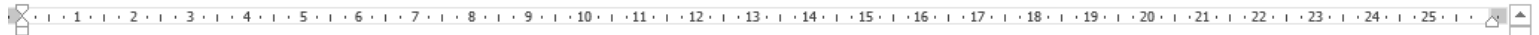

Dear Shaddai and team

Thank you for availing yourselves for the meeting on Tuesday. Please find attached the attendance register for your records.

Just to summarise, the meeting was held in response to the email received from the Department in response to the Hydropedology Peer Review of the Geotechnical studies (see attached email for ease of reference).

During our meeting it was clarified that the Department is satisfied with the information submitted to-date and does not require an additional specialist study, however, a written statement from the freshwater ecologist in response to the issues raised in the hydropedology peer review of the geotechnical studies must be provided as part of the Water Use License Application (WULA).

Dr. Liz Day also confirmed that the risk matrix provided will not change as a result of the peer review and the Department acknowledged and accepted the fact.

I also clarified that the GA applies to Erf 242 and the WULA applies to Erf 212 and the Department confirmed that this remains their understanding of the Protea Village applications.

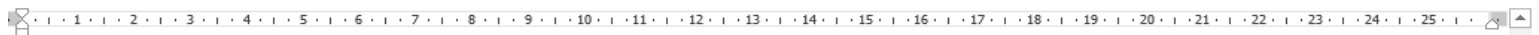
